

What is your baby's corrected age?

Corrected age reflects your baby's "developmental age" based upon due date, rather than date of birth. Knowing the corrected age of your baby is important, as they might experience milestones differently and achieve them at a pace closer to their corrected age than their birth age.*

You can use the calculation tool below, or use this simple calculation: **(weeks from birth) – (weeks early) = corrected age.**
